Level A - Field Operations

In cooperation with Red Deer College, YREC is pleased to offer the Gas Process Operations program in Edson.

The Gas Process Operations program provides training to plant operators working in the industry. The program consists of four levels of training - A, B, C, and D.

The objectives of the Gas Process Operations Program are twofold:

- to supplement on-the-job training with technical knowledge about gas processes as well as knowledge of the underlying concepts, basic background, and plant safety; and
- to give gas plant operators the opportunity to obtain an industry-recognized certificate, certifying four levels of knowledge.

Level A - Field Operations

Gas Processing concepts taught include exploration for petroleum deposits, testing, completion and production methods, hydrogen sulphide safety, and confined space entry.
