PLEASE NOTE: The above costs are for MacEwan SOWK courses only. University Transfer courses through GPRC are in addition to these costs. Please see Lynn Seabrook for details on University courses.

BOOKS - Textbooks vary in cost from course to course. Generally, students should allow \$150 for textbooks per course (there are no textbooks required for field placement courses).
Books for Winter 2010, Fall 2010 and Winter 2011 should be 3 x \$150 = **\$400 each term**. For Spring 2010, students should plan for 2 x \$150 = **\$300** to cover the costs of textbooks.

SUICIDE INTERVENTION TRAINING – Students are required to complete a two day Suicide Intervention Training workshop as part of their SOWK 105 Field Placement course. Since some students already have this training, the \$75.00 special fee associated with SOWK 105 is waived. Students who do not have this training should plan to complete it through local agencies, school boards, or other training opportunities. Students may also join the Social Work full-time program training in Edmonton (usually held in October) if they wish. Because the \$75.00 special fee has been waived, any fees charged for this workshop are the responsibility of the student.
